Statement of comparison of training as a paraveterinary veterinary assistant

In this questionnaire you will find the core tasks and work processes that the Dutch veterinary paraveterinary assistant must at least master in order to be recognized and registered in the veterinary medicine register. In order to properly assess your application for recognition of your diploma, we ask you to indicate per work process whether this was covered in your training and how many hours you received lessons in it. This not only concerns the required knowledge, but also the question of whether you can carry out the work process and the associated skills/actions.

Send a syllabus or study guide

In addition to this completed form, it is necessary to send the syllabus/study guide for your study. This must describe the content

of the various course components. Indicate for each work process on which pages this information can be found in the syllabus/study guide.

Signing form

A representative of the program must sign the completed form. By signing, your training indicates that the work processes you have completed have actually been covered in your training and that you have mastered them. You may complete the form yourself or have it completed by your department.

Conducts public-facing activities (B1-K2-W2)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Organizing or supporting the organization of public-oriented activities. Developing information material or giving a demonstration in which animals are moved or shown. Instructing employees. 		
Manages pharmacy (P5-K1-W1)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Providing pet supplies and prescription veterinary drugs. Dosage calculation, packaging and labelling. Informing and advising the customer about use, administration, storage and side effects. Monitoring the stock. Ensure safe storage. Ordering products. Monitoring quality procedures. 		
Manages practice rooms and instruments (P5-K1-W2)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Preparing instruments and tools. Set up equipment. Regulate climate in rooms. Ensuring hygiene and disinfection. Monitoring the sterility of instruments, tools and rooms. 		
Carries out desk work, makes an inventory of the care demand and advises (P5-K1-W3)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Taking care of regular counter activities, clarifying the customer's question, determining the nature of the complaint and the urgency. Scheduling appointments. Independently performing Paraveterinary consultations (<i>weight guidance, diabetes, puppy consultation</i>) 		
Assists with consultations (P5-K2-W1)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assisting the veterinarian with examinations and treatment. Putting patient and customer at ease. Assist in handling and restraining. Providing instruments. Assisting with euthanasia. Conducting a clinical emergency examination. 		
Assists with operations (P5-K2-W2)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Carrying out pre- anesthetic examination. Assist in administering anesthesia. Monitoring the patient during surgery and keeping records. Provide instruments and monitor sterility. Adjust dosage in consultation. Care for the patient and operating room after surgery. Monitor the condition during recovery. 		
Performs professional dental cleaning (P5-K2-W3)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Inspecting, palpating and performing dental cleaning. Determine any defects and report them to the veterinary doctor. Observe the patient carefully. 		
Performs lab work (P5-K2-W4)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Receive and store samples. Taking samples. Examine and / or send samples. Manage laboratory and inventory. In any case, urine, blood and feces tests. 		
Performs or assists in imaging techniques (P5-K2-W5)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Taking x-rays and assisting with other imaging techniques. Set up device. Assess whether the quality of the scan is good enough.
